## Langley for Families Donates \$75,000 to Local Organizations

NEWPORT NEWS, VA – The Langley for Families Foundation has donated \$75,000 to local organizations that focus on family issues in the Hampton Roads area. The nine recipients mark the Foundation’s first grant awardees since launching last December.

The Foundation is self-funded and run solely by a volunteer Board of Directors as a 501c(3) thereby maximizing dollars distributed in the community.
